Whereas, his tenure would last 13 years, the last 3 of which he served as Director of Communications and Sustainability; and

Whereas, he played a significant role in the development of several key District projects such as expanding recycling and diversion at notable Peninsula community events, such as the AT&T Pro-Am, the Concurs d'Elegance, and the Big Sur Marathon; and

Whereas, he was key in coordinating the development of the District's award-winning food waste recycling program, from the back of the kitchen to the anaerobic digester and

Whereas, he was largely responsible in "modernizing" the District's approach to public education and outreach, remaking the District's website, educational materials and beginning social media outreach; and

Whereas, he was an effective advocate in partnering with our member agencies as they were some of the first in the state of California to develop model ordinances for Construction and Demolition recycling, the banning of Styrofoam for fast food packaging, and the banning of single use plastic bags, and straws on demand; and

Whereas, he and his public education team helped put on one of the most successful "Open Houses" in recent Peninsula memory in which 700 people attended a two day "MRF 2.0 Festival" that kicked off our very successful facility.
