### Financial Review - October 2020

- October tip fee revenue is \$647K or 29.6% over budget. October tip fee revenue is \$187K or 7.1% higher than the same month last year. YTD tip fee revenue is \$10.4M and is \$1.5M or 16.2% above budget and is 2.1% higher than the same as the same period in fiscal 2020.
- Other revenue in October is \$1.0M and is \$310K or 42.1% over budget. Other revenue is above budget due to.
  - Power sales are \$30K or 24.7% over budget.
  - MRF related revenue is \$274K or 52.7% over budget.
- Other revenue for the YTD is \$4.2M and is \$1.2M or 39.5% over budget. Other YTD revenue is above budget due to.
  - MRF related revenue is \$3.2M and is \$1.1M or 51.0% over budget.
- October total revenue is \$956K or 32.7% over budget. YTD total revenue is \$14.7M is \$2.67M or 22.0% above budget and is \$1.0M or 7.5% higher than the same period fiscal 2020.

#### October Expense

- Employment expense is \$1.1 million and is \$26K 2.3% under budget.
- Operating supplies are \$439K which is \$347K over budget. The overspend is primarily due to maintenance of roads around the landfill.
- Repair and maintenance costs are \$309K and are \$75K over budget primarily due landfill gas monitoring material costs.
- Recycling services are \$164K and are \$27K or 19.5% over budget primarily due to higher MRF related processing fees.
- Total operating costs are \$2.8 million and are \$302K or 12.1% over budget.
- Net income for the month is \$1.0 million and is \$694K or 211.5% over budget and is \$336 or 50.0% higher than October 2020.

### Financial Review – October 2020

#### Operating Expense & Net Income ('000) cont.

#### Year to Date Expense

- Employment expense is \$292K or 8.1% over budget for the year primarily due to higher salary expense partially offset by lower than budget unemployment claims expense.
- Outside services are \$32K or 33.2% over budget partially due to temporary staff costs.
- Operating supplies costs are \$656K and are \$288K or 78.3% over budget primarily due to the cost of site maintenance materials.
- Repair and maintenance costs are \$194K or 20.7% below budget and are essentially the same as the same period last year.
- Fuel costs are \$317K and are \$100K or 24.0% under budget and \$89K or 21.9% lower than fuel costs through four months in fiscal 2020.
- Total operating expense is \$10.4M and is \$137K or 1.3% under budget and \$848K or 7.6% lower than the same period last year.
- Net income for the year is \$3.9 million and is \$2.6 million over budget and \$1.6M or 72% higher than the same period in fiscal 2020.
