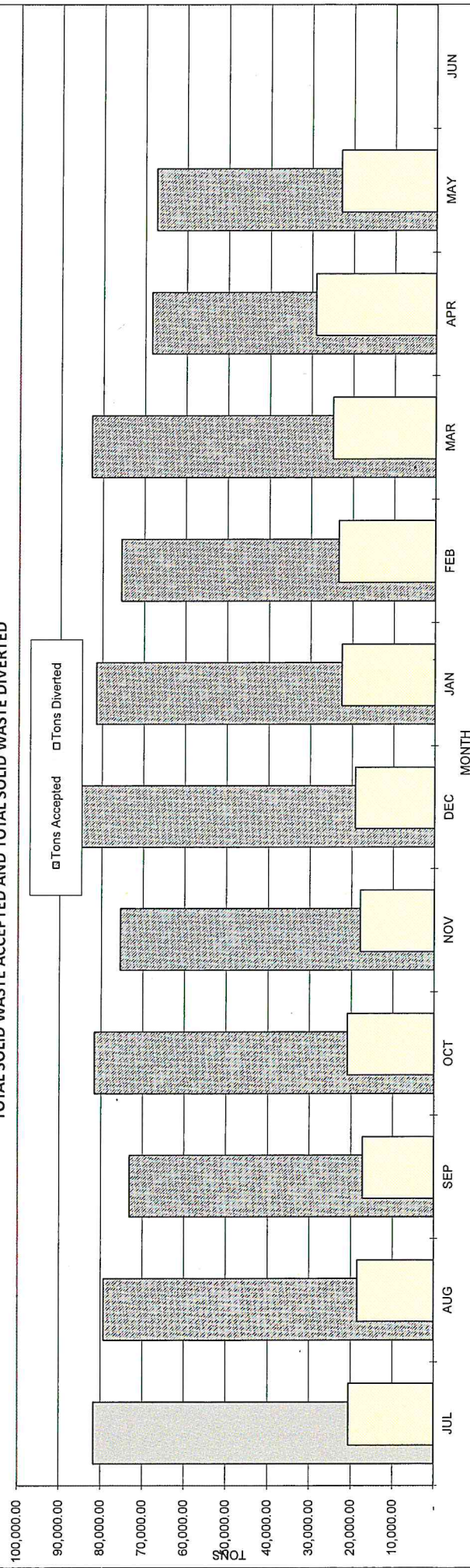

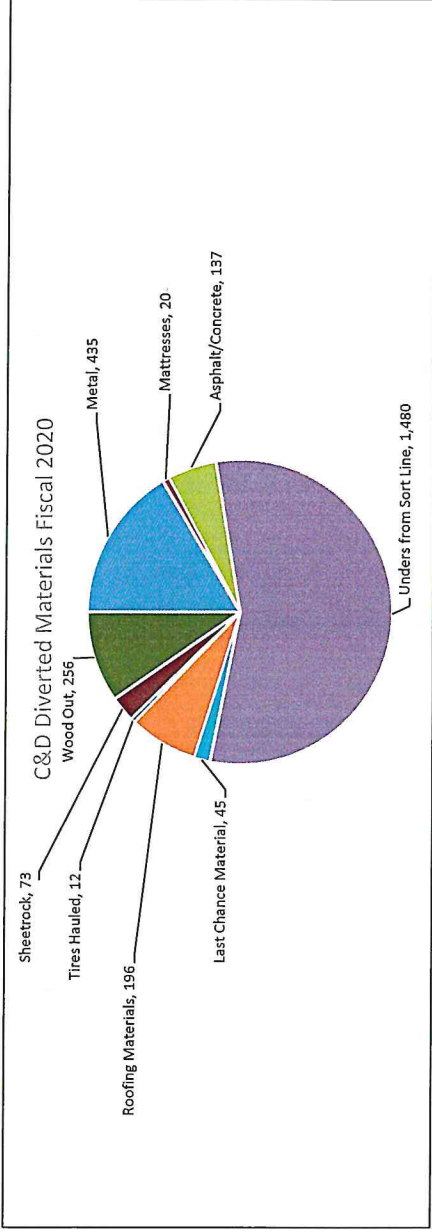
TOTAL SOLID WASTE ACCEPTED AND TOTAL SOLID WASTE DIVERTED

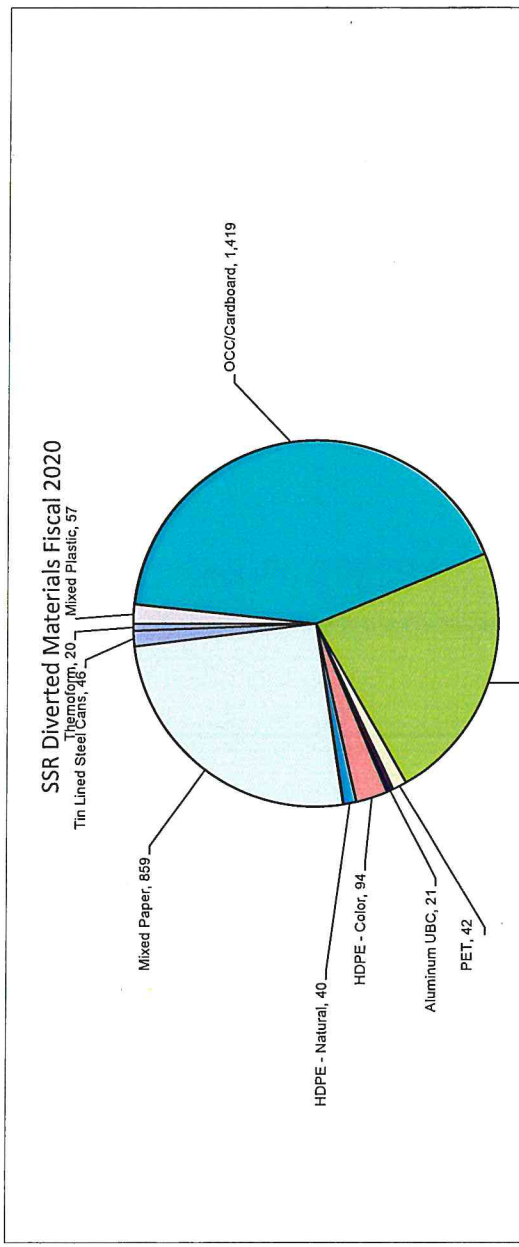

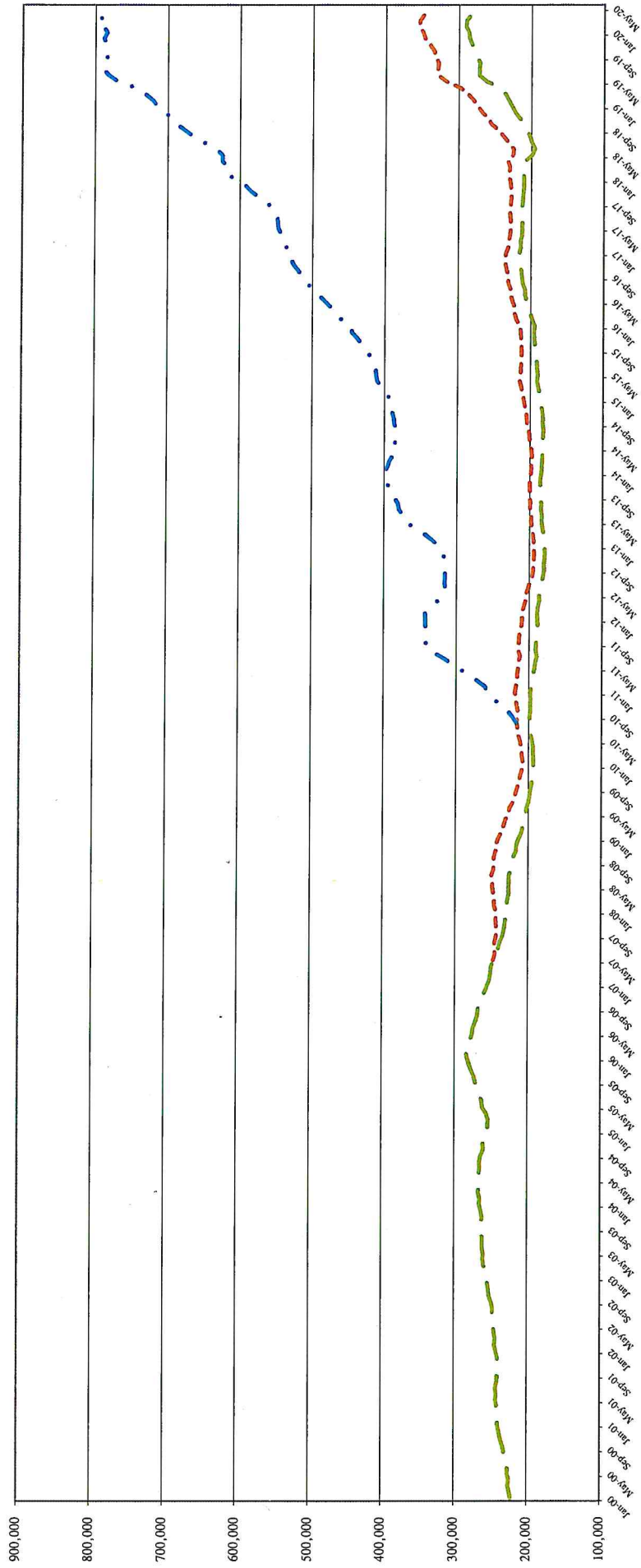
