## CONCRETE AND ASPHALT ACCEPTANCE CRITERIA

It is District's policy to accept loads of clean concrete and asphalt at the rate of \$1 per ton (\$5 minimum). This material is crushed and recycled for use as base rock. As contamination\* seriously affects the material processing and may reduce the quality of the recycled product, it is very important to keep loads of concrete and asphalt clean. ("Clean" means no trash or debris mixed with load.)

We request your cooperation in helping to make the concrete and asphalt recycling program a success. This program is mutually beneficial in that it saves you from having to pay the regular disposal fee and it conserves valuable landfill space.

**Please Note: The waste category and disposal fee is based on the District staff's visual determination of the waste material's physical properties and degree of cleanliness and/or contamination. This determination is final.**

<b>Materials Accepted at the Concrete Recycling Area:</b>		
Maximum size of concrete (3.5'x 3.5' x 8") with rebar or pipe exposed 8" or less in length.		\$1 per ton/ \$5 min.
Clean oversized concrete with rebar or pipe more than 8" exposed.		\$10 per ton/ \$10 min.
Clean mixed loads of concrete/ asphalt and the following materials		\$2 per ton/ \$5 min.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• ceramic or ceramic tile</li> <li>• concrete block &amp; roof tile</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Gravel/ rock /stone</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• marble</li> </ul>

<b>Materials Accepted at the Asphalt Recycling Area:</b>		
• asphalt pieces	• ceramic reflector buttons	• hot mix

<b>Examples of Unacceptable Materials and Contaminants are:</b>		
• adobe clay bricks	• glass	• pipe
• base rock	• ice plant	• terra cotta tile
• chalk rock	• lava	• stucco
• debris or trash	• metal	• wood waste
• dirt in excess of 10%	• plastic	• yard waste
Loads containing unacceptable materials are charged at the regular disposal rate of \$51.75 per ton. *Contaminated or oversized loads dumped into the clean stockpiles will be charged at the problem waste rate of \$90 per ton.		

**THE DISTRICT DOES NOT ACCEPT WASTE THAT IS DEFINED AS HAZARDOUS WASTE UNDER RCRA OR CCR TITLE 22.**
