Summary of Finance Committee Meeting of February 3, 2016

The Finance Committee met on February 3rd at 9:00 a.m., at the District administrative offices. Committee members in attendance were Directors Bales, Laska and Pendergrass. Staff members in attendance were Tim Flanagan, Chuck Rees, Guy Petraborg, Jeff Lindenthal and Becky Aguilar. George Thacher from Rob Wellington's office was also in attendance. The purpose of the meeting was introduction of Fiscal Year 2016/17 Budget assumptions and timeline, provide updates on the Capital Projects, the Monterey Bay Community Power Project Development Advisory Committee (PDAC) and General Management comments. There was a scheduled closed session item regarding property negotiations. Discussion is summarized below and followed the attached agenda.

Preliminary Budget for Fiscal Year 2016/17

Staff presented the documentation of key assumptions to be used in the preparation of the Preliminary Budget. The Committee discussed the key assumptions and provided guidance to staff for preparation of the Preliminary Budget. It was noted that the construction of the Materials Recovery Facility (MRF) Improvements will cause operational disruptions. Staff identified key assumptions that will allow for monitoring of the financial impact during the implementation of the improved MRF operations. Staff presented a proposal for an Organization Restructuring. Discussion followed and the Committee requested that staff update the presentation for the financial impact compared to actual costs and current budget costs prior to the presentation to the Board.

Capital Project Updates

Guy Petraborg updated the Committee on the Capital Projects. Additionally:

<u>Landfill Gas Update</u>: Engine #4 is on schedule for online in late February 2016. Engine #3 is on schedule for being on line my mid-year 2016.

<u>Compressed Natural Gas Facility</u>: The fueling station has been delayed from using pipeline gas and slow fill facility due to the timing of the paving of the Truck Yard and need of subcontractors to utilize the space for staging construction materials for the Maintenance Facility structures.

<u>Truck Yard and Maintenance Facility</u>: Staff noted that the contractor has increased their performance and completion is now anticipated to be completed after mid-year 2016.

<u>Materials Recovery Facility Equipment Installation</u>: The General Arrangement Drawings are complete and manufacturing is commencing with start-up anticipated in January 2017

Update on the Monterey Bay Community Power Project Development Advisory Committee (PDAC)

It was noted that the PDAC will meet on March 10th in the District's Board room, and that it is open to interested parties including senior staff of District member agencies.

<u>Update on Franchise Agreements</u>. Jeff Lindenthal brought the Committee up to date on meetings between the commercial customers from Carmel and Pacific Grove with GreenWaste Recovery and the District regarding the rates being charged under the franchise agreements for services. After these meetings, it appears that with realignment of various services, the total cost of commercial collection can be reduced.
