

WASTE SCREENING AND ACCEPTANCE PROCEDURES

Materials considered Special Waste, which require District review and acceptance, include the following:

- Soil
- Drilling Mud/Dredgings
- Non-Friable Asbestos containing materials
- Oversized Wastes (boats, mobile homes, trailers, etc.)
- Animal Carcass Waste

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• Liquid Waste/Biosolids (materials with moisture content greater than 50%)

The waste screening process is as follows:

- 1) The customer is required to provide MRWMD with a completed submittal package that corresponds to the Special Waste type. *See links below.*
 - Soil/Mud Submittal Checklist
 - <u>Non-Friable Asbestos Submittal Checklist</u>
 - Oversized Submittal Checklist
 - Animal Submittal Checklist
 - Liquid/Biosolids Submittal Checklist
- 2) The customer will submit, for review, the completed submittal package to the District at <u>dramirez@mrwmd.org</u>
- 3) The District will review the package and inform the customer if additional tests or information are required for review.
- 4) The District will review and respond within 5 working days after receipt of all completed information with a determination if the waste can be accepted at MRWMD
 - a. If material **meets** the District's acceptance criteria
 - i. An acceptance letter with job reference number is issued for use upon arrival at the scales.
 - b. If material does not meet District's acceptance criteria
 - i. Please consider other disposal sites including:
 - Johnson Canyon Landfill Class III Landfill (831) 675-2165
 - Altamont Landfill Class II Landfill (925) 455-7300
 - Kettleman Hills Facility Class I Landfill (800) 963-4776

Monterey Regional Waste Management District (MRWMD) implements the Waste Acceptance Review and Waste Screening Program to assist in preventing disposal of hazardous waste containing materials at the District's Class III non-hazardous, solid waste landfill. All Special Wastes must be pre-approved by MRWMD prior to acceptance and delivery of the material to the facility. It is the responsibility of the Generator to certify, in writing, that the materials brought for disposal at MRWMD are non-hazardous per CCR Title 22 Section 66260.

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
