CALL FOR BIDS:

You are invited to bid on a General Contract for construction improvements to the existing Scalehouse Building, public restrooms, accessibility upgrades, and associated site improvements. The engineer's estimate for construction is approximately \$900,000. Bid Documents (including plans, specifications, contract forms, bid forms and conditions) may be obtained by contacting gpetraborg@regenmonterey.org. Bids shall be submitted on the Bid Forms provided with the Bid Documents.

Sealed bids will be received at the MRWMD office located at 14201 Del Monte Blvd., Monterey County, CA 93908 until **3:00 p.m., Friday, May 12, 2023 Thursday, June 8, 2023** (P.O. Box 1670, Marina, CA 93933-1670) at which time they will be publicly opened and read. Any bids received after that time will not be considered. Oral, telephonic, facsimile, or telegraphic bids are invalid and will not receive consideration.

All prospective general contract bidders are welcome to schedule a pre-bid walk through of the project site to be held at the MRWMD facility. An appointment can be scheduled by emailing dramirez@regnemonterey.org.

Each bid shall be accompanied by a certified or cashier's check or bid bond in the amount of 10 percent of the total bid price payable to the MRWMD as a guaranty that the bidder, if his/her proposal is accepted, will promptly execute the contract, secure payment of worker's compensation insurance, and furnish a satisfactory faithful performance bond in the amount of 100 percent of the total bid price.

The successful bidder must be licensed in the State of California, be registered with the State of California Department of Industrial Relations as a Public Works Contractor, is legally required to pay prevailing wage, and must demonstrate acceptable experience of the type of work described in the Bid Documents. MRWMD reserves the right to waive any irregularities and to reject any or all bids.
